

Cosmetic Teeth Whitening

Cosmetic Teeth Whitening was formerly led to some extend by celebrities and those in the public eye. However the procedure has increased in popularity across society, particularly in preparation for; social events, interviews or indeed a simple treat.

Zoom Cosmetic Teeth Whitening (In-surgery Procedure)

Two factors for selecting Zoom Cosmetic Whitening are; convenience and result. In just over one hour, teeth brighten by up to nine shades.

The procedure involves the use of a whitening gel that contains hydrogen peroxide. A brightening light is used to accelerate the process.

Immediately after your Zoom Cosmetic Teeth Whitening

One completion of your Zoom cosmetic teeth whitening, the first 48 hours are important in order to maximise your whitening result.

For the first 48 hours, dark staining substances should be avoided such as:

Coffee or tea (without milk), cola or other dark coloured drinks, red wine, soy sauce, mustard or ketchup, food containing dark fruits, food with a dark sauce and tobacco products.

Home Whitening (Self-directed Procedure)

Home Whitening offers flexibility on where and when you whiten your teeth. Gum shields are specially manufactured which cover your upper and lower teeth. Whitening gel that contains hydrogen peroxide is carefully applied to each gum shield and the shields are then placed over the teeth.

Typically home whitening is performed for up to 90 minutes per evening, over 5 to 7 consecutive evenings.

Home whitening can be used as a stand-alone treatment, or it can be used in conjunction with Zoom.
