

Mouth Cancer

Mouth cancer is dangerous and can be found in any part of the mouth. It can appear as an; ulcer, growth or swelling that fails to heal after two weeks. Mouth cancer can also present as a white or red patch in the mouth.

If you have any signs like those above, it is important that you contact your Dentist (or other healthcare professional) for examination.

In most cases, the diagnosis will be harmless and easily addressed. However in the event of a cancer diagnosis, early detection is vital for successful treatment.

The following factors can increase risk of Mouth Cancer:-

Use of tobacco
Drinking more than your recommended weekly units of alcohol
Excessive exposure to sunlight
Poor diet and nutrition
